## Pastor's Corner

Is Ordinary time just ordinary? Unlike pagan religions which see time as an endless cycle, Christians see time as being linear; it has a beginning and will have an end. Within Christianity's linear, "big picture" sense of time, the passing of hours are experienced as cycles of meditations on holy things. Ordinary Time refers to the period of the Catholic Church's liturgical year that falls outside of the major seasons (Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter). Ordinary Time is called "ordinary" because the weeks are numbered. The Latin word ordinalis, which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word ordo, from which we get the English word 'order'. Thus, Ordinary Time is in fact the ordered life of the Church - the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in the Christmas and Easter seasons) or in more austere penance (as in Advent and Lent), but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ.


## Mary Son's Kneeler Pilgrimage

## *Group Information*


6:30-7:30PM Bi- Weekly 2x a month
