Pastor's Corner

On June 13, the Church celebrates the 109th anniversary of the June 13, 1917 apparition at Fatima. During this apparition, Our Lady revealed an important part of God's plan for salvation and peace—devotion to her Immaculate Heart. She told Lucia that she would take the three visionaries to Heaven—Francisco and Jacinta soon. “But you are to stay here some time longer. Jesus wishes to make use of you to make me known and loved. He wants to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart.” Lucia was her faithful instrument for the spread of this devotion for 87 years.

In July, Our Lady told them: “You have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If what I say to you is done, many souls will be saved and there will be peace”.

Let us renew our devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary as we offer reparation to the Immaculate and Sacred Hearts.
